

The Koekelberg Basilica, or "the Basilica of the Sacred Heart" in Brussels is the fifth largest church in the world. It is also the third-largest cathedral in the country and the biggest building of the Art Deco style in the entire world.

Built during the late 1900s, the Justice Palace of Brussels (Palais de Justice) remains the most significant court building in Belgium. It's also truly massive at 26,000 square meters/280,000 square feet. When it was built, it was the largest building in the world, and today it is still one of the biggest and most remarkable edifices in Europe.
